

COVID-Related Policy and Procedure

(Update due 2/14/2021)

Masks must be worn at all times covering mouth & nose by anyone entering the theatre.

Productions/Performances:

1. Masks will be required during all rehearsals and performances.
2. Six feet distance will be required.
3. Any costumes/costume pieces will not be shared.
4. Sharing of any props or other items (such as microphones) will be limited.
5. Performances may be adapted rather than a full production with limited cast members.
6. We may allow **limited** live audiences at each performance. Each performance will ALSO be recorded.
7. No food or drink will be allowed inside the theatre space.

Volunteers/ Audience:

1. Volunteers/ Audience members must self-monitor each day for any of the following new or worsening signs or symptoms of possible COVID-19.
 - A. Cough
 - B. Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - C. Chills or Repeated shaking with chills
 - D. Muscle pain
 - E. Headache
 - F. Sore throat
 - G. Loss of taste or smell
 - H. Diarrhea
 - I. Feeling feverish
 - J. Known close contact with a person who is lab-confirmed positive for COVID-19
2. No touch thermometers will be used to monitor staff temperatures prior to entering the building. Volunteers/ Audience members who have a fever of 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit or above will not be allowed into the building.
3. Volunteers/ Audience members must wear a mask at all times.
4. No food or drink will be allowed inside the theatre space.
5. Volunteers will be allowed to check-in no earlier than 5 minutes before the start of the rehearsal & 30 minutes before a performance.
6. Audience members will be allowed to check-in no earlier than 15 minutes before the start of the performance.

Cleaning:

1. High touch areas will be cleaned after every rehearsal, production, & performance by volunteers.
2. Volunteers will be required to wash their hands before each rehearsal & performance.
3. Hand sanitizer will be provided before each performance for audience members.
